VERIFI: The Utility Tracking Tool

VERIFI is a free, open-source software tool developed by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) to assist in tracking and managing utility data. VERIFI enables users to monitor energy usage, utility costs, and water consumption to support informed operational and financial decision-making.

Key Features:

- **Comprehensive Utility Tracking:** Monitor energy consumption, water usage, and utility data across multiple facilities and see a holistic view of organizational performance.
- **Analytical Tools:** Access regression modeling to evaluate energy intensity and performance metrics.
- **Data Visualization:** Utilize interactive graphs and charts to identify anomalies, trends, and correlations between energy use and variables such as production levels or weather conditions.
- **Reporting Functions:** Generate standardized reports to monitor progress toward energy and performance goals, supporting DOE programs like Better Plants.
- **Weather Data:** Utilize data from public databases to calculate weather predictors that may contribute to energy consumption.

Benefits:

- **Enhanced Energy Management:** VERIFI provides detailed insights into energy consumption patterns from utility bills.
- **Performance Tracking:** The software tracks utility usage patterns across facilities, supporting improved operational performance.
- **User-Friendly and Secure:** VERIFI is platform-agnostic, available on Windows, Linux, and Mac systems, and ensures data privacy by storing information locally on the user's device.

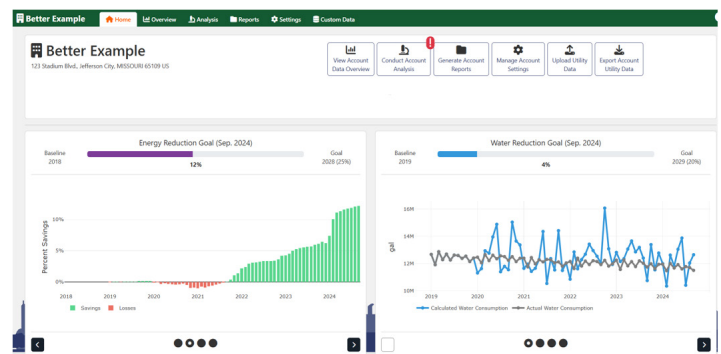
